Dear Colleague,

Thank you for the confidence you express while addressing the Office of the Ombudsman in Albania, asking our commitment "to publicly express the need for impartial and full investigation, without political considerations, of the findings of the Report" of Mr. Dick Marty, Special Reporter of the European Council.

I share with you the same assessment about the universal and unlimited nature of human rights, just as I really appreciate their contribution to human dignity and peace in our region.

Of course, just like You, I am familiar with the Draft Project in question, which is soon expected to be discussed by the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe.

Without any prejudice and stripped of any political consideration, please allow me to pronounce myself positively on the investigation and reinvestigation of such matters whenever and wherever they have occurred: either in Albania or in Kosovo, in Serbia, Macedonia and elsewhere in the world.

The highest Albanian authorities have also expressed their opinions about the full investigation of this matter, by officially and publicly addressing the international bodies, whose jurisdiction would enable the realization of this mission, so sensitive to the conscience of our peoples and nations.

I tend to share the opinion that any case, however absurd in appearance, should be addressed as real and potential in terms of professional commitment and cooperation required and offered by interested parties.

While remaining just as interested as you in the settlement of this and all issues having to do with killed or missing individuals, regardless of their ethnicity, in any place

they might be, I believe that our professionalism and impartiality will be the best help we could give to peace, understanding and democratic developments in our region, with no doubt a European future, and free of the shadows and myths of the past.

On this occasion, please allow me convey to you my readiness to cooperate in the protection and promotion of human rights and their universalism.
